Dale Fickett is an entrepreneurship professor at the University of Richmond, a contributing author at Forbes, and president of RVA Works. This Virginia nonprofit helps people overcome economic barriers to business ownership by providing a range of educational and financial services. He provides federal entrepreneurship policy advice to elected officials in Washington and has served on numerous board appointments at the U.S. Senate Small Business Award Panel, the Virginia Catholic Conference, and for Virginia Secretary of Commerce & Trade.

Dale has lectured and conducted research on entrepreneurial finance and developmental economics, recently winning the Terry Weisenberger Service Award.
